








**Parent Notes:** This week we will be looking at objects in the sky: sun, moon stars etc. Perhaps you can discuss this with your child at home, look at the moon and night and talk about the shape etc. This week we will focus on the colour Orange and will be looking at the phonic sound "aaaa". It would be nice if you can bring in some objects beginning with the letter A for our sound table and also point out objects that start with this sound at home.
