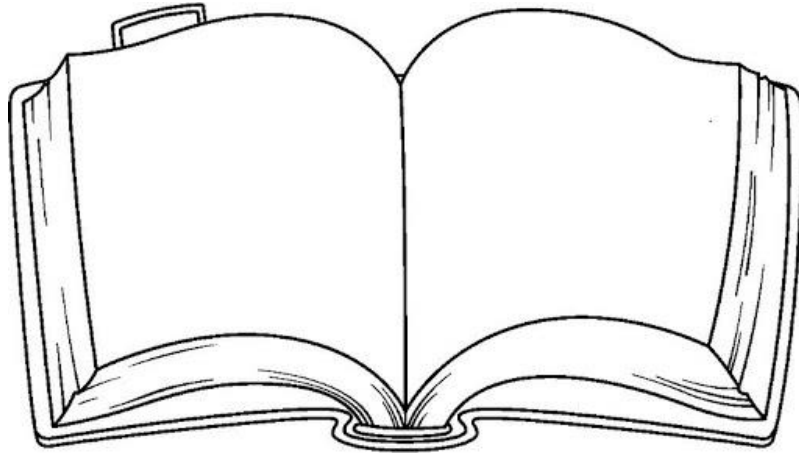

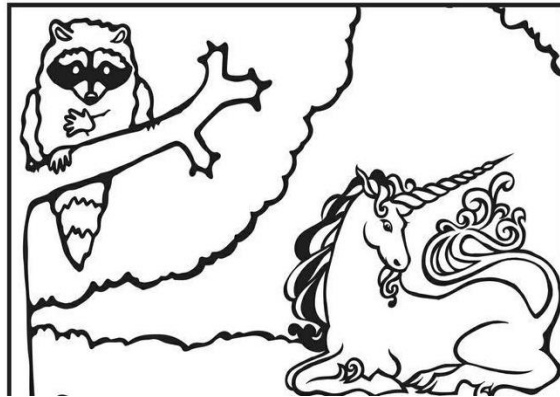
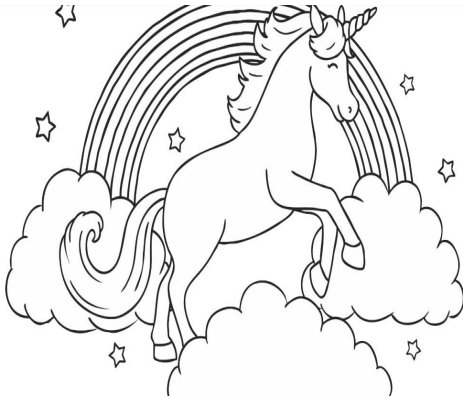
Practice Exercise 1

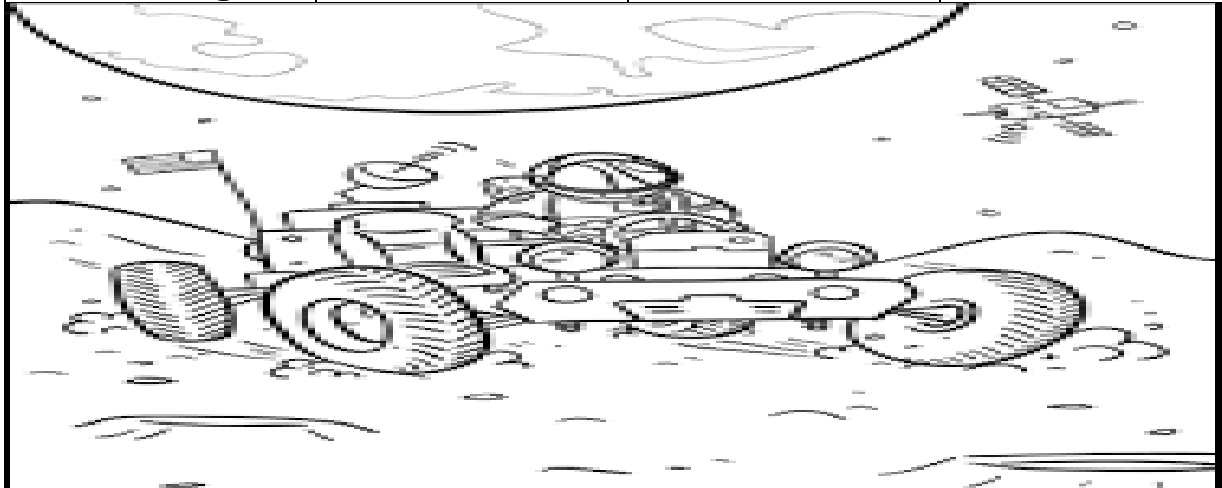
